Greetings Middle and High School Families,

With the number of ECPS Middle/High School staff who have either tested positive or are required to quarantine due to a COVID-19 exposure, we have reached a critical juncture in our ability to provide in-person instruction at our Middle/High School. As a result, it is unfortunate I must inform you that we must pause in-person instruction for **6th-12th grades only**. Therefore, beginning tomorrow, November 12, 2020, all 6th-12th grade students will temporarily shift to remote eLearning. Our current plan is for students to return to in-person instruction on **Monday, November 30, 2020**.

This will only affect the Middle and High School.

Lybrook Elementary will operate on a normal schedule.

As promised in our Return to Learning Plan, if we needed to transition to remote eLearning there would be far more rigorous requirements and more robust academic instruction than what was put in place during the March 2020 closure. To keep this promise, I have been working with the MS/HS administration team in drafting a detailed plan for instructional delivery over the next two weeks. This afternoon the MSHS staff finalized the remote eLearning instructional plan. Please see the attached schedule below. This will also be shared with students and on our District website.

Lastly, I would like to emphasize it is important that we all understand that although we are going to remote learning, **Learning is NOT Optional**. In order to maintain our continuity of learning, the daily schedule, attendance, and instructional progress will remain consistent with our in-person learning expectations. Teachers will be conducting live instruction for each class and attendance for every class is expected. If for some reason a teacher is unable to teach remotely due to an illness, or other factors, all work for that class will be available in Google Classroom.
