- ~Recognize features of a sentence and use them correctly.
- ~Demonstrate understanding of spoken words, syllables, and sounds.
- ~Distinguish long from short vowel sounds.
- ~Decode regularly spelled one-syllable words.

- ~Know final -e and common vowel team conventions for long vowel sounds.
- ~Read on-level text orally with accuracy, appropriate rate, and expression.
- ~Use context to self-correct words.
- ~Print all upper- and lowercase letters.
