Lybrook Elementary School Annual Education Report (AER)

February 2022

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2021-2022 educational progress for Lybrook Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2018-19. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2017-18. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2016-17. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Lybrook Elementary School has not been given one of these labels. Lybrook Elementary School continues to put a strong focus on improving student achievement through our strengthened curriculum, improved student investment in education, and parent engagement.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

- 1. Assigning pupils to Lybrook Elementary:** Eau Claire Public Schools participates in "Schools of Choice" and welcomes students who accurately complete the process. Students are assigned to Eau Claire (Lybrook) Elementary School by grade level based on age. We currently serve grades Preschool-5th grade. Our goal is to maintain balance in all of our classrooms throughout all of our buildings.
- 2. The Status of our School Improvement Plan:** The School Improvement Plan, is now called The Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process (MICIP). MICIP provides the District with a streamlined, integrated process and platform for Diagnosing needs in support of educating the whole child (Where are we now? Where do we need to go?); Creating a high-quality plan that focuses on

systems and supports (How will we get there?); Identifying how to use various funding streams and grants (How will we get there?); Monitoring and evaluating implementation and impact of the plan (How will we know?).

To ensure Lybrook has equitable opportunities, environments, and supports that result in students that are healthy, safe, engaged, challenged, and supported, our improvement goals were drafted based on a needs assessment using our State and local assessment data. We have student achievement goals in ELA and Math and additional goals in the area of MTSS. We gather data every year and create challenging, yet appropriate goals for our school. We will continue to evaluate our assessment and instruction methods in order to see increases in student scores.

3. **Specialized Schools:** Along with our regular education services provided through our District we are pleased to be able to provide additional services through Berrien RESA. Berrien RESA provides services to special needs students through Blossomland Learning Center, Lighthouse Education Center, and Berrien County Hearing Impaired Program. Furthermore, Berrien RESA works in conjunction with the Berrien County Juvenile Detention Center to provide services to students being housed at the center.
4. **Core Curriculum:** Lybrook Elementary does not vary from the state's model. Our curriculum is aligned with the state model and incorporated into daily teaching plans and delivered by each of our grade-level classroom teachers. 6. **Parent Teacher Conferences:** Lybrook holds two conferences for parents; one in the fall and one in the spring. During 2020-2021 Lybrook had 78 percent of parents attend parent-teacher conferences in the fall. Lybrook had 66 percent in the spring. 2019-20 Lybrook Elementary had 90 percent of parents attend parent-teacher conferences in the fall. Lybrook had 75 percent in the spring.

Eau Claire Public Schools is extremely proud of the work that our Lybrook teachers and students have put into our program. We work collaboratively to ensure that all children experience a positive, caring, and rigorous learning environment. At all levels, we celebrate small steps and special accomplishments whether they are academic, social, athletic, or extra-curricular. With our continued efforts on curriculum, school culture, and community engagement the future of our school's performance is certain to continue to rise.
